- Ended week with a dive on NSU's coral nursery sites



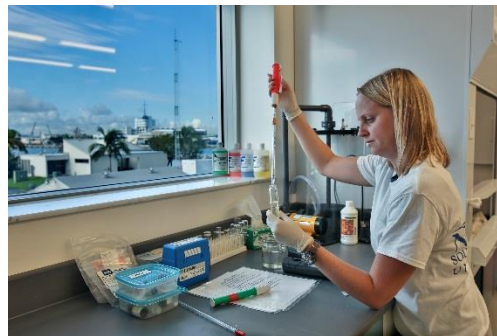
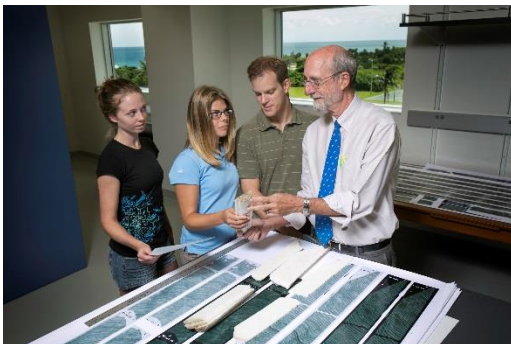
National Coral Management Fellows
